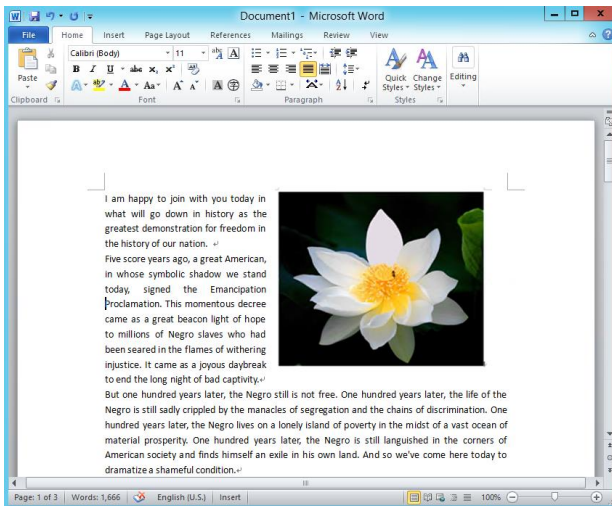


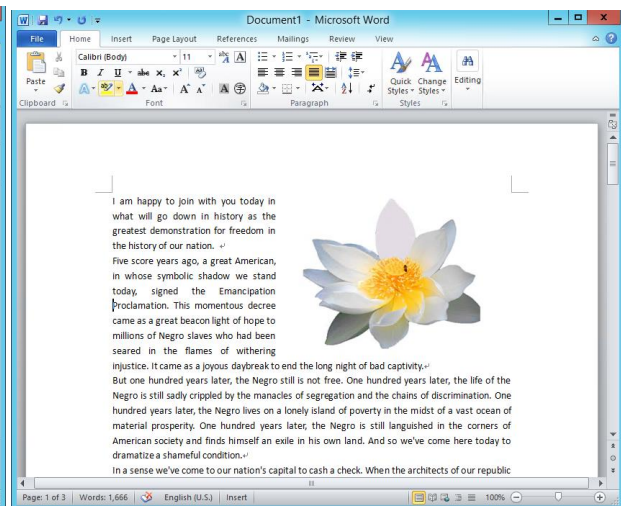
HOW TO REMOVE THE BACKGROUND OF A PICTURE?

We have to do some modification to the picture for a friendly layout, such as optimize filter or remove background. Normally, we will find some software like Photoshop. This time we will talk about in Word 2010, PowerPoint 2010 and Excel 2010 you can remove a background from a picture to accent or highlight the subject of the picture or to remove distracting detail. In many cases, you can get the result you want without any additional work by experimenting with the position and size of the marquee lines.

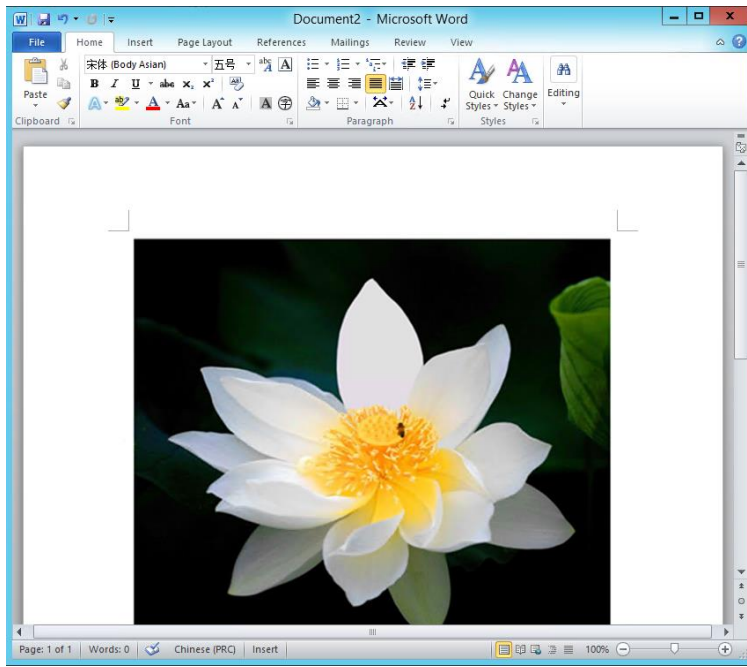


Original picture

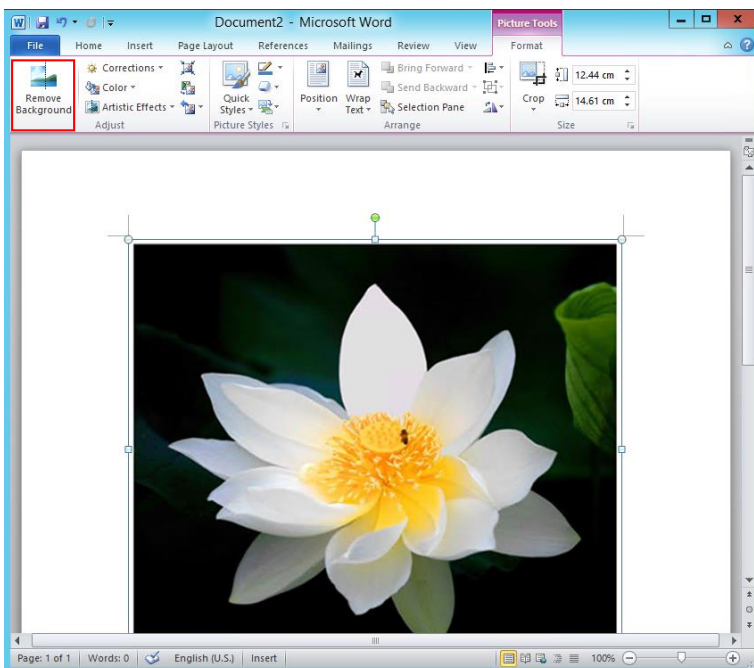


Same picture with the background removed

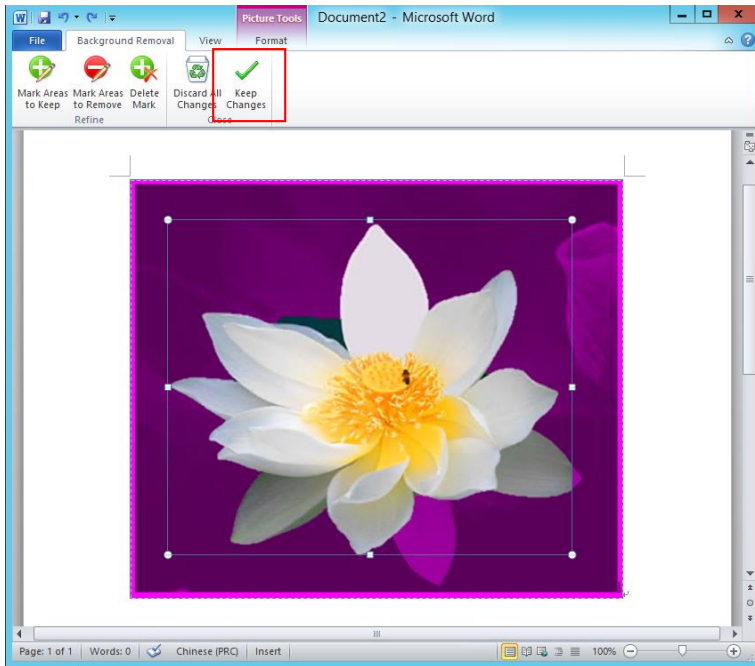
1. Insert a picture into your document
