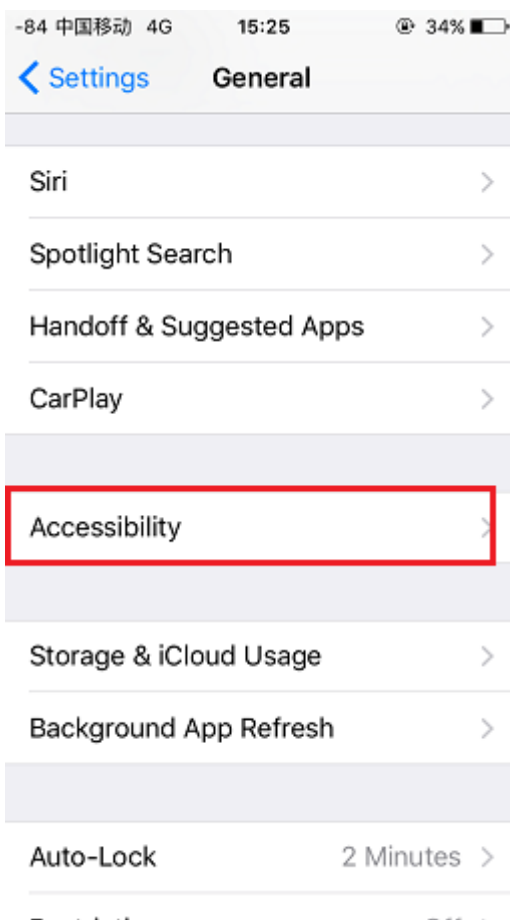


## How to protect my iPhone

You may have meet such kind of scenario, some of your colleagues or friends may borrow your cellphone to make a phone call temporary. But how to protect your phones content, like Photos, Wechat...

The iPhone do have a build-in function named **Guided Access** which can keep someone else stay on the application. For example, he wants to make a phone call, and he can only make a phone call. Now, we want to share with you how to setup on your iPhone.

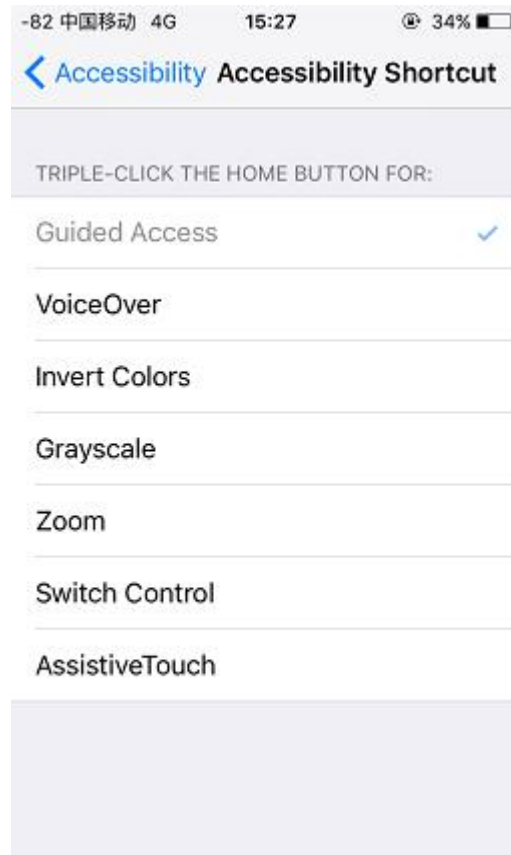
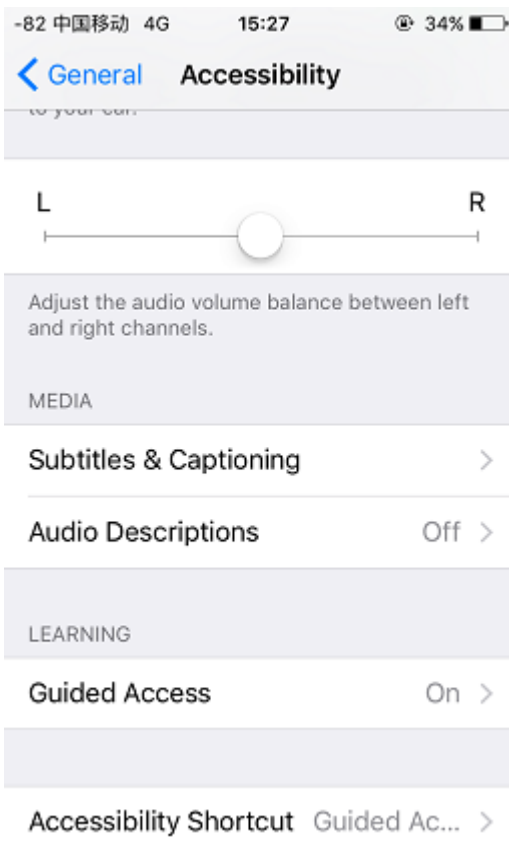
1. Settings → General → Accessibility, and there is an option named **Guided Access** at the bottom of the screen.



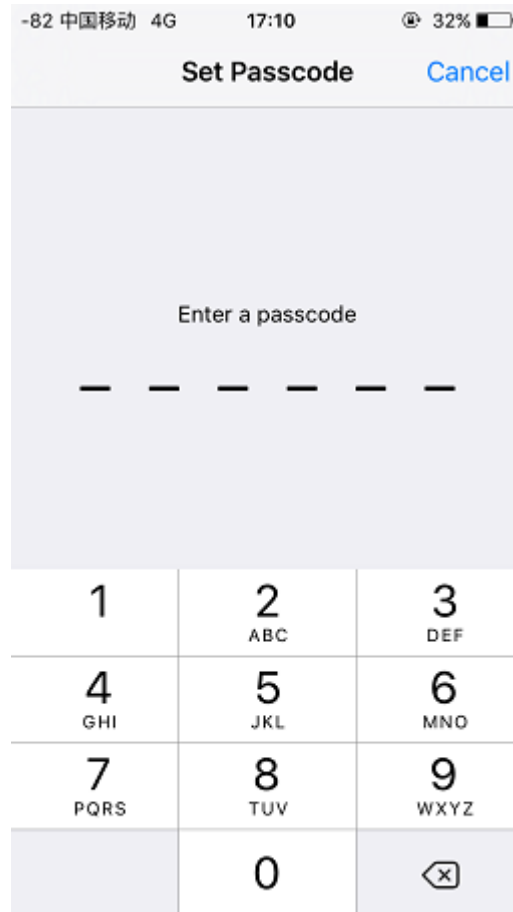
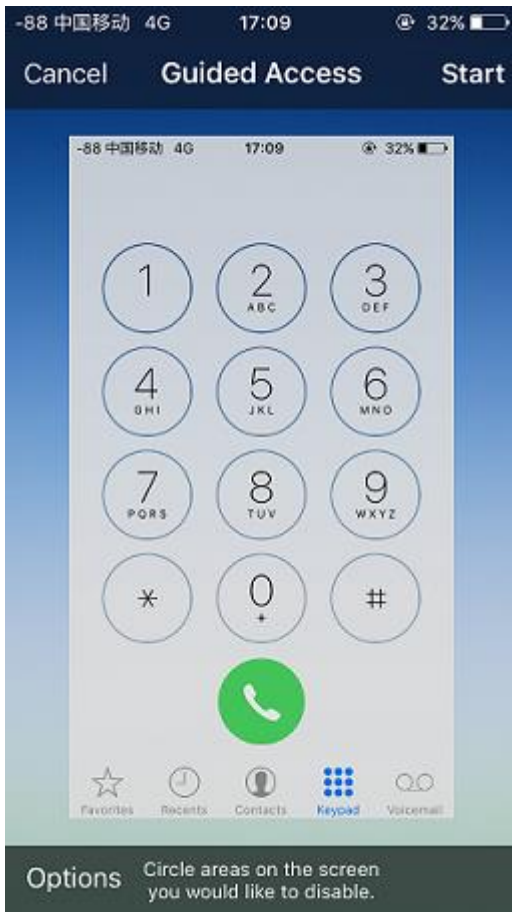
2. Enable the **Guided Access** option, please enter your passcode settings if you are first time to use. The passcode is required for quit from the **Guided Access** after activated.



3. Make sure the triple-click the home button for **Guided Access** is checked under the Accessibility Shortcut.



4. Open your Dial panel, triple-click the home button, and click start on the right top. And now you should only Dial panel accessible.



5. For quit from the Guided Access, just triple-click the home button and enter your passcode or use your touch ID.
